


Victorian Education collaboration

Some of Malaysia's leading institutions of higher learning separately signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with top Victorian higher education providers at a Higher Education Forum organized in Malaysia recently.

These collaborations allow Malaysia to strengthen its readiness for the ASEAN Qualifications Reference Framework (AQRF) and raise its global competitiveness. Furthermore, these MoUs offer new pathways for qualification, academic research and mobility for diploma, degree and PhD students.

The collaborations involve Swinburne University of Technology and University of Malaya, RMIT University and UCSI University, and Swinburne University of Technology and ICAN College.

Steve Herbert, Victoria's Minister for Training and Skills, was there to witness the signings between representatives from the various organisations.
