even had a chance.

I was stunned when I got THE call! As a scholarship student, expectations were high, and it led me to learn responsibility and accountability. Something that I carry with me to this day.

I started my career in non-profit Protect and Save the Children, before moving on to public relations. In mid-2015, I took up my current position. I also dabbled in the performing arts (as both actor and writer) in four local theatre productions from 2010 to 2011.
