

# Mind games can decide winners of overall trophy

**BANGSAR:** The battles of the minds will take place on Oct 30-31.

An international chess and a Chinese chess tournaments will be staged by UCSI University.

The Malaysian Association of Private Colleges and Universities (MAPCU) chess competitions are for MAPCU members to pick up points before year's end.

MAPCU tallies up points that its members have garnered over the year at the end of December.

Universities and colleges are awarded 10 points for winning any of MAPCU's official sports events.

Second place is worth seven points while five and three points are given to third and fourth placed teams respectively.

With the top honour still up for grabs, the chess tournaments now play a vital role in deciding where the overall trophy will head to with only a few tournaments left on the calendar.

Last year's overall winners, INTI International University (IIU), face a struggle to hold on to their title as both Taylor's University College and former champions HELP University College, who held the title from 2004 to 2008, performed impressively during the recent MAPCU Sports Carnival in July.

The MAPCU International Chess Tournament and MAPCU Chinese Chess Tournament will take place at the South Wing of UCSI University.
