In their design of an exhibition booth for the recent Architectural Students' Works competition held by Persatuan Arkitek Malaysia, they used only natural materials. The booth, named Fundamentals, was mainly constructed from finger-joint wood members in line with theme The Evolution towards Green Technology.

team members, the booth illustrates the simplicity of conservation, and constitutes an appeal to the public to have a cleaner, greener environment.

The design won them the first runner-up prize and RM500.

Students worked closely with each another to complete the project, which included solving design and construction problems. Part of the experience also involved staying overnight until the wee hours of the morning to set up the booth

at a shopping mall where the exhibition was held.

The students also participated in the Esquisse Project Competition which tested their creativity by requiring them to think of design solutions within a limited time.
