A STUDY OF MALAYALEE FAMILIES IN SUBANG JAYA

ABSTRACT

This study seeks to explore whether Indian Malayalee families are preserving or losing their mother tongue in Malaysia. These are the research questions proposed: 1) What language is used by the Malaysian Malayalee family and in what domain do they use this language? 2) How has multilingualism affected the Malayalee families in Malaysia in communicating with each other? 3) What are the causes of language shift in Malayalee family in Malaysia? This research uses a qualitative study using questionnaire as the data collection technique. Open ended question and multiple choice questions were asked. The finding for the first research question is English is used in all domains of communication. The finding for the second research question is; Media was the major cause of multilingualism effect in Malayalee family communication. It played a major role in how each family communicated with each other. The finding for the third research question is; the causes of language shift are Attitudinal, political, educational, social status, social approvals.
