## UCSI students raise RM2,300

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The students of UCSI University's Medical and Optometry Faculty have raised RM2,328.15 for earthquake victims in Palu, Sulawesi, Indonesia. The money was presented to Malaysian Relief Agency (MRA) president Dr Mohd Daud Sulaiman at the university's campus in Cheras yesterday.
